生 命 与 事 奉

事奉的根据

「第二天，摩西进法柜的帐幕去。谁知，利未族亚伦的杖已经发了芽，生了花苞，开了花，结了熟杏。」
(民十七 8)

亚伦知道杖发芽，乃是神使之发芽，是超越天然能力的。神藉此对以色列民说话，也对亚伦说话。从那天起，亚伦认识了：一切的事奉乃是根据于发芽，不是出于自己。今天我们要在神面前事奉，也应该知道，事奉在于复活；而复活在于神，不在于我们。

现在我们要问，何谓复活呢？复活乃是说，一切不是出乎天然的，不是出乎自己的，不是凭自己所能的；复活是我来不及的，复活是我办不到的。任何一根杖可以刻上花，涂上颜色，但发芽是我办不到的事。全世界的手杖，没听说有任何一枝用了几十年，还会发芽的；而亚伦的杖竟然发芽开花了，这是神作的。全世界上的妇人，也没听说有任何一个经期已经绝了，还能生产的；而撒拉竟然生了以撒，这也是神作的。所以撒拉乃是代表复活。复活是什么呢？复活乃是凭自己不能，凭神能；凭自己不是，凭神是。复活就是说，不管自己如何，只根据出乎神的。不管你是否比别人聪明，是否比别人口才好，你若有一点的属灵，那个根据定规不是你自己，乃是因为神在你身上作了事。如果亚伦愚昧到一个地步，对别人说：「我的杖与你们的杖是不同的，我的杖是特别的光、特别的亮、特别的直，所以能够发芽。」这该是何等愚昧可笑的话。我们若有一分钟想自己和别人不一样，那是最愚昧的事。纵然你身上有丝毫的不同，

也是主作的。复活就是指明一切出于神的。

一切事奉的原则，乃在于发芽的杖。神把其他的十一根杖都发还，只把亚伦那根发芽的杖留在约柜里，作永远的记念。这个意思就是说，复活乃是事奉神的永远原则。事奉神的人，乃是一个死了的人，再复活了。神一直向自己并向祂的子民见证，事奉神的权柄，乃是根据复活，不是根据人自己。事奉神的事非经过死而复活，就不能摆在神面前蒙悦纳。复活就是神，不是我们；复活就是神能，我不能；复活就是神作的，不是我作的。凡自己以为不错的，凡对自己有错误估价的，这人永远不知道复活是什么。任何人绝不能对自己有丝毫误会，以为自己能。如果有人一直自以为了不得，以为自己行，以为自己有用，这就是不认识复活的人。你也许认识复活的道理、复活的理由、复活的结果，但你不认识复活。所有认识复活的人，都是对自己绝望的人；所有认识复活的人，都是知道自己不能的人。天然的力量还存在时，复活的能力就无法彰显。撒拉自己会生时，以撒就不能生。凡是你能的，乃是天然的；你不能的，才是复活的。所以今天人凭自己原有的能活，就没有复活。人凭自己原来的能，就不是复活；人凭自己原有的是，就不是复活；人凭自己原有的有，也不是复活。我们必须承认自己一点不能、一点不是、一点没有，像死狗一样；这时，我们身上还能活的，就是复活。
